## THE CEYLON NATIONAL CHAMBER OF INDUSTRIES - HISTORY

The Ceylon National Chamber of Industries (CNCI) was established in the year 1960 and in 1969 it was incorporated by Act No 10 of Parliament of Sri Lanka. It is the oldest Chamber of Industries in Sri Lanka. At present there are more than 300 industrial enterprises registered as members of CNCI.

### OUR OBJECTIVES

■ To promote and foster industrial growth in Sri Lanka and to co-operate with the Government and other associations in the attainment of such objectives

■ To promote and protect the interests of persons connected with industrial undertakings in Sri Lanka

■ To do such other matters as may be necessary to carry out the objectives of the chamber

■ To represent and express on industrial, commercial and economic matters the opinions of the industrial community in Sri Lanka and to aid, assist and co-operate with others in such representation and expression

■ To advise and communicate on economic & industrial matters with public authorities, and similar associations in other places and with individuals

■ To foster fellow feeling and co-operation among industrialists, workers and consumers in all matters of common interest

■ To mediate on behalf of members and settle disputes with Government departments, Ministries etc.

■ To promote and take action necessary to expand the exports of industrial goods of Sri Lanka

■ To collect and circulate statistics and other information relating to industrial, commercial and economic matters

■ To publish industrial, economic, commercial, scientific, technical and vocational journals and literature and to propagate industrial education in Sri Lanka

■ To maintain a library of books and publications on industrial, commercial and economic matters



■ To organize and establish and assist in organizing and establishing vocational and industrial training institutions in Sri Lanka and to arrange and assist in specialized training of personnel of member companies.

■ To organize and participate in industrial exhibitions and seminars

■ To assist and provide facilities for industrial research and to take necessary steps to further the introduction of more efficient manufacturing techniques

## OUR SERVICES

■ We are the voice of industry against under invoicing, dumping, sub standard goods entering the country etc.

■ Whenever foreign trade delegations visit Sri Lanka we are able to arrange one-to-one meetings with the firms they represent.

■ Joint venture projects are also promoted.

■ We organize seminars and workshops on current topics, affecting our membership.

■ The CNCI issues a fortnightly newsletter free of charge. This contains articles, views Trade inquiries and features on current topics.

■ Each month we make available a comprehensive list of import/export inquiries and joint venture offers.

■ We are one of the very few Chambers authorized to issue Certificates of origin.

■ We conduct job specific training programmes with a faculty of elite trainers. Our certificates and diplomas are much sought after.

■ Government consults this Chamber before making amendments to existing commercial laws, regulations, etc.
